

Rationale for Changes



- Increases in 2024/25: Costs for the club have been increasing significantly, most notably were:
 - increases for senior coaching costs (£13.2k) implemented following a market review, and
 - An increase in electricity (+£10k) since our fixed rate expired.
 - There have also been increases in food costs, umpiring fees and M1 league charges. This has led to a deficit of £13k in the 2024-25 season which, after cost control measures, was reduced from a forecasted £20k.
- Further cost increases for 2025/26: There are 2 significant cost increases this coming season:
 - £15 per member increase in the England hockey affiliation fee (this is to go towards individual accident insurance for members, state school hockey support and TV/online coverage of international matches), and
 - £5 per member increase from the Sports Club to maintain the clubhouse.
- Relatively flat income in recent years: We have not increased subs and match fees in line with inflation over the past few years, choosing to keep them low through Covid, and in the years following, given the rising cost of living. This is no longer sustainable for the club. Overall, the subs and match fees are in line with UK inflation (RPI) for the past five years the time when subs/match fees were last significantly increased.
- Sponsorship and fundraising not guaranteed income: Given the resources and commitment required to attract sponsorship and fundraise at a significant scale, we cannot rely on these as guaranteed sources of income and have taken the decision that the club should be breaking even on the provision of hockey based activities, i.e. through subs match fees and other 'paid for' hockey provision.

- A clubhouse and bar, including pitchside refreshments
- Fantastic changing facilities and showers
- Regular coaching with qualified coaches

- Access to year around hockey including summer leagues and summer tournaments
- Insurance cover through England Hockey including personal accident cover whilst engaged in any hockey activities with the club.
